
ANSWERS TO PRAYER REQUESTS

MINISTERING AT GLOBAL TRAINING NETWORK

ife is worth the living, but how many Christians really believe this? Jesus said, "My purpose is to give life in all of its fullness." (John 10:10b) There are those, and they can be counted in the tens of thousands, who believe that life is worse than a bad dream. Why is there so little

is worse than a bad dream. Why is there so little joy among God's people today?

At the heart of Global Training Network's ministry is a passion for people, to help those who are hurting and desperate. Certainly, ministering to people directly or through the agonizing demands of intercession takes time and concentrated effort, but when you have the truth and the tools to see lives transformed—and lives are transformed—it is all worthwhile.

To answer our question, the joy of the Christian life is gone because the world has invaded the

hallowed halls of Christian living and appears to be winning! There is little difference in external appearances between the Christian and the unbeliever. There are as many divorces among the Christians as among the non-Christians. Christians are just as promiscuous as their secular counterparts. There are just as many abortions among church members as the non-churched.

Although it saddens the heart, it is no surprise when we meet with teenagers who are deeply depressed, who are starving themselves or bloodying themselves by cutting. Could it be that you too are living in an unlivable situation or faced with circumstances beyond your ability to handle? Do you think of suicide as a fix or drugs as an answer? Is pornography a problem or are you in a marriage that you feel is doomed?

Life doesn't have to be this way. We at Global Training Network believe that there are answers to life's problems, that Jesus was right when He promises fullness of life. Our agenda with those who come is a life transformed. Jesus told us that in the world we would be faced with intolerable situations, but almost in the same breath He calls us to come to Him who are weary and heavy-laden, and He will give us His rest. (Matthew 11:28)

A dear and wonderful friend wrote the following poem after her life was changed and transformed by knowing Jesus intimately. This poem expresses a life change – a heart transformed by the **power of God**.

he world is full of little known facts. For example, did you know that the Lone Ranger premiered on TV in September or that Miss Emma Nutt of Boston became

the first female telephone operator in this country in September 1878. And, that in September of 1935 the first Santa Claus School opened in New York?

I am quite certain that you are astounded by the profundity of the foregoing. Yet, I wonder about some of the lesser known facts in the Bible.

There is one that is a barnburner. It is this; the Word of God became lost in the House of God.

This is a most amazing story. Josiah was a King of Judah, and at eight the youngest king ever to sit on the throne. Unlike the idol loving kings before him, young Josiah consistently sought the Lord. The history of the previous kings of Judah and Israel is one of naked and perverse idolatry and rebellion against God. The Temple fell into ruins and somewhere in the midst of all the debris lay the Word of God, lost in the Temple of God.

Josiah was determined to restore the Temple and he instructed the high priest to begin. One day the high priest went to the Temple to record the money given toward the restoration. Cleaning off a place to work, he discovered the dust covered scroll containing the Word of God. Amazingly, the Word of God was discovered lost and abandoned in the House of God. This discovery brought the king and the kingdom back to God (2 Chronicles 34, 35).

Fast forward to our day and age. If what Barna says is true that only 25% of Evangelicals read their Bible regularly, then might we assume that the Word of God has been lost, as it were? Not by chance, but

by choice. We dare not let Satan win by default.

While the world tries to eradicate the Word of God and the presence of God, nothing can be done to still the Spirit of God! No matter the forces arrayed against us, we will win – greater is He who is within us than he who is in the world.
