Healthy Christians Have Double Vision

If we as Christians do not have double vision, then there is something radically wrong with our Christianity! Christians who do not have double vision have fallen into the Thomas Syndrome of believing only what they see. Their creed is “Seeing is believing.” Single sightedness is a deadly peril to one’s faith. If our Christianity is to be real and powerful and victorious then we must develop double vision.

It would be trite to say that double vision humanly speaking is not a serious problem, but for the Christian it is a necessary imperative. How so? Obviously, we see through eyes of sight. “Seeing is believing,” is an old cliché that reveals much of what the world believes. But, the Christian has another faculty of sight, one that sees far clearer than the eyes of sight.

The Apostle Thomas fell into the trap of believing only what he saw through eyes of sight. We find this in John 20:26-29. As the other disciples excitedly told Thomas of what they had seen, he refused even to consider it. “I won’t believe it unless I see the nail wounds in his hands, put my fingers into them, and place my hand in the wound in His side.” It would seem that Thomas was an apostle of seeing is believing.

A little over a week later, Thomas came face to face with reality. Jesus forced the issue with him. “Don’t be faithless any longer, just believe!” Jesus admonished him. Then Jesus said something of tremendous importance to every Christian and especially to us who read this short homily. “Blessed are those who have never seen me, but believe anyway” (John 20:29).

What Jesus is saying is what Thomas could not see through eyes

of sight, others could see through eyes of faith! It is the eyes of faith that allows us to see what others cannot. This is an incredible truth! It means that you and I have the ability, the faculty if you will, according to our faith, to see as real what others cannot see or even imagine.

Take Moses for example. He could have been a king of the greatest nation on earth at the time, he chose rather to follow God. But what kept him going through thick and thin? Certainly it wasn’t the children of Israel, they almost drove him to distraction. No indeed, it was something else, something wonder-fully else. It is this, and within this is the very heart and core of faith: *“It was by faith that Moses left. He was not afraid of the king. Moses kept right on going because he kept his eyes on the One who is invisible”* (Hebrews 11:27).

Moses could see Jesus through eyes of faith, that is what kept him going. We find the same with Jesus when He was here on earth. What he saw the Father do He did. How could Jesus in His humanity see what the Father was doing, through eyes of faith! Let us take this down to the most practical level. Can you or I be like Moses, like Jesus? Of course, by using the same prism they used, faith! Jesus is always there to correct our vision, allowing us the privilege and luxury of God-given double vision. Is He a great God or what!

2012 has been a crazy, or should I say trying, year for you. Let's start by explaining what all you have been through this year.

In March I had knee replacement surgery, then in June I fell down our stairs and had to have surgery for a fractured hip, and during this time they found skin cancer and I had surgery to remove it in September. I praise God for His protection when I fell down our stairs that I wasn't more severely hurt and that the doctors were able to remove all the cancer.

How did you deal with six months of being out of commission?

I continually claimed James 1:2-6. So even in the midst of great pain, I knew God was with me and going to take me through each step no matter what the outcome.

Now that you are back to your counseling schedule, what are some of the issues the women are facing?

Marriage, children leaving home for the first time, physical and mental pain due to health issues that comes with getting older, self-image, past hurts and legalism. I want each lady to realize how special she is in God's eyes. I help ladies deal with the pain from past issues which has kept them in bondage and affected so many of their past and current relationships. I have them memorize and meditate on God's promises. I help them understand that God's promises apply to them no matter what they are going through. I've seen real victory when someone will apply God's word to their every day needs and work through the pain of their past. I've seen them have God's inner peace no matter what they are going through when they truly see and believe God is with them and realize the Holy Spirit wants to live and work through them day-by-day.

I've been a CASA Advocate for 11 years and I'm responsible to gather information that will enable the court to understand the child's situation and the best placement for that child. It is very rewarding to get to know these children, to help them understand there are people that unconditionally love them, believe in them and think they are very special.

As of this September you have been married 60 years. What advice do you have for couples?

To have them understand they are responsible for themselves. It is not the spouse's place to change their mate or blame them for what has gone wrong in their marriage. Each person is answerable to the Lord. As each person chooses to put Christ first in their life, grow personally in their faith and allow the Lord to change them individually, it is amazing how the Lord will renew their love for each other. I find it impossible to live in a marriage unless we learn to accept our spouse as God accepts us! It is imperative that each person allows the Holy Spirit to change the other person. VENEER

What will it take to snap us out of our lethargy, out of our comfort zone? Natural disasters come with ever increasing rapidity, dangers are ever present, America is polarized politically, not realizing nor accepting that these great tragedies are but the beginning of God's judgment on America!

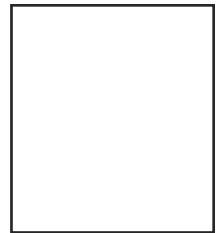
