

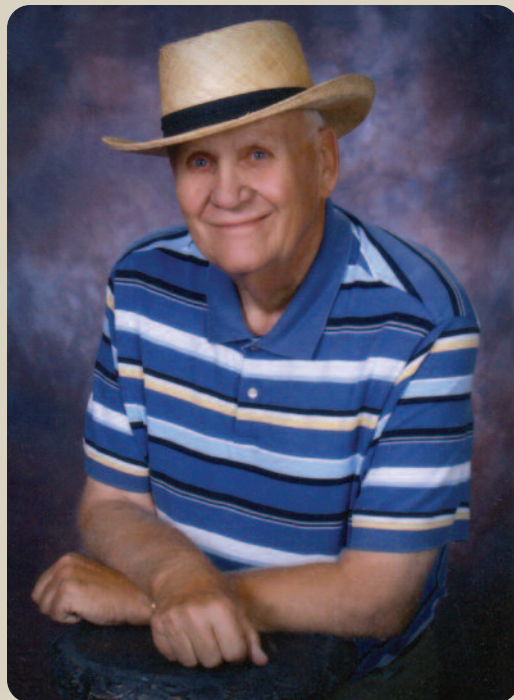
Jim's newest Release – a daily devotional!

Jim Craddock was a man that challenged others by his perseverance and radical obedience to God and His Word. Jim's passion was to tell others about how they could personally know God, his son Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, and explain that knowing Them could transform a person from the inside out. Each word Jim wrote by pen was to impart a deeper understanding of the Word of God. Jim knew, firsthand, that to have a life worth living was to see life from a spiritual perspective and not from an emotional one. He wanted nothing more than for every person to know the God of the Bible that can make every ordinary person extraordinary as a child of the Most High King.

This was one of the last projects Jim worked on prior to his death on April 1, 2014, and he was looking forward to getting it published. Jim's prayer for each person reading this daily devotional was that they would read each day with an open heart, allowing God to take these words and draw them into a deeper understanding of God in their life. His prayer was for every person to choose to live a Holy life that would set them apart. He spent his life loving others and sharing the depth of God's love for them. He wanted all people to know how great the God of the living Bible is.

Jim was born July 6, 1932, in Pueblo, Colorado, where he was reared and graduated from high school. He often said he only heard Jesus Christ as an exclamation but during the Korean War when he was serving with the 5th Explosive Ordnance Disposal squad in Okinawa, Jim came to Christ through Bob Boardman who was with the Navigators, a Colorado Christian organization. God used this time to grow Jim in the Word and helped establish his heart for ministry.



Jim's task was removing and detonating dangerous live ammunition ranging from artillery shells to bombs that remained from World War II. Death was a constant companion with the sensitive explosives and Jim made it a mission to inform those around him that salvation and eternal life had been made available to them by and thru Jesus.

Jim married his high school sweet-heart, Doris, on September 7, 1952, just three months before being called into service for our country. When he was discharged, he returned to Doris and began his studies at the University of Colorado. Upon graduation, he joined Campus Crusade for Christ and served for 15 years as regional director on college campuses at Colorado, Oklahoma University, Tulsa and in the states of

Arkansas, Louisiana and Texas.

Then in 1973, he and Doris founded Scope Ministries International where they pioneered Biblical counseling and provided the counseling free to the community and world. Along with his counseling responsibilities, he authored books on many subjects that confront believers and non-believers and lectured on college campuses and at conferences in the United States and other places in the world.

In 1986, Jim founded the International Association of Biblical Counselors which he used to unite the discipline of Biblical counseling. Throughout many years, the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association (BGEA) called on Jim to lead the counseling





at The International Conferences for Itinerant Evangelists at Amsterdam 83, 86 & 2000 and to provide counseling at many of the BGEA Conferences around the world. Jim had a real heart for pastors and worked with many churches in the U.S. and abroad which led to trips to Mexico, Cuba, Russia, Peru, Holland, Israel, India, Moldova, Kiev, and Africa.



Immediately after the Oklahoma City 1995 Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building bombing, Jim, Doris and staff members at Scope counseled first responders, aid workers, medical personnel and volunteers that numbered in the thousands, some continuing today.

As a direct result of Jim's experiences in the Oklahoma City bombing, BGEA called on Jim and Scope staffers again to assist in establishing the prayer center immediately following the World Trade Center attacks in New York City on September 11, 2001. Using these experiences, he wrote a Rapid Response Manual which became the prototype BGEA uses to train rapid response chaplains who assist at man-made and natural disasters across the United States and throughout the world.



THEN IN 2006, Jim started Global Training Network (GTN) with his wife and daughter Christi. This unique nonprofit, non-denominational 501(c)(3) faith-based ministry was founded on the sufficiency of Christ and His Word. GTN is designed to utilize Biblical truth in the development of material and programs that

will enhance a Believer's walk with Christ and their ministry for Christ. GTN provides personal and group Biblical guidance and mentoring, as well as teaching and training both locally and internationally. To learn more, visit GTN at www.gtnonline.org.

Jim's heart-felt conviction was not only Biblical counselors, but all Believers, must be solid in the Word of God so they could provide the answers to hurting people. From this conviction, Jim has authored over 27 publications, including Pneumanetics, Pneumanetics Original, Tidbits of Grace, and co-authored Be Transformed. Jim continued his counseling, writing, teaching and mentoring until his last days.



At 81 years young, Jim was scheduled to teach in Cuba. The day after the Cuba trip was cancelled, Jim became very sick. He was diagnosed with a rare and untreatable form of liver cancer. On April 1, 2014, he went home to his Heavenly father.

Jim was excited about residing with the Person who had given meaning and purpose to his life. He clarified what a special gift his family had been to him; his appreciation for the lasting friend-ships God had provided



with clients and supporters of the ministries; and the journey God had created for him.

Jim and Doris are longtime members of Covenant Community Church in Yukon and also attended Frontline Church. For many years they led many Bible studies and Biblical outreach conferences for churches throughout the Oklahoma City area.

The family had a visitation on Saturday, April 5 at Demuth Funeral Home and Jim's memorial service was held at Frontline Church on April 6. Condolences for the family were left at christigtn@cox.net. In lieu of flowers memorials were given to GTN to continue Jim's legacy.

Jim is survived by Doris, his bride of almost 62 years; his children, James, Doug (wife Lisa), Mike, Danny (wife Debbie) and Christi; 14 grandchildren, Joanna, Jonathon, Michael, Monica, Matthew, Haley, Hanna, Jeremy (wife Nichole), Will, Andrea, Danielle, Leah and Emma; 3 great-grandchildren, Tristian, Libby and Gracie; brother Jerry and wife Peggy and sister-in-law Shirley; many nieces and nephews and thousands of friends all over the world.

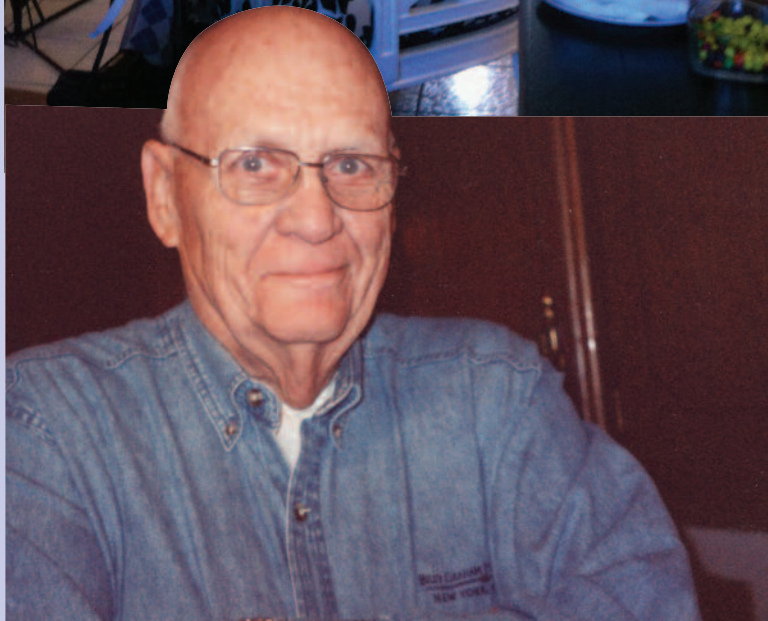
Wishing You Comfort

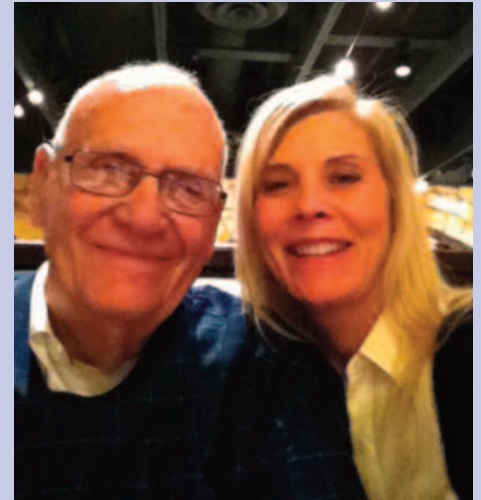
Our family has been blessed by so many of you taking the time to write us letting us know how Jim made an impact on your lives and ministries. We are forever grateful!

A DAUGHTER'S HEART...

He left a great legacy to so many and he did it in such a way that if you weren't paying attention you would miss it but you were affected by it all the same. In pondering about my father's legacy I would say he was a man that loved much. He not only raised his children and his grand-children but he made everyone, especially children, feel special. People were of upmost importance to him. In thinking about his Godly character he was the real deal. He lived out his Christian walk, not by being perfect, but by demonstrating how to love and forgive. He lived an unwavering faith and taught by example. To our family he was our steadfast rock. It's hard to replace someone so loveable and dependable but what he left was for us to love God, the person that allowed him to be our steadfast rock. He knew the secret...that he could not live life on his own but by allowing the Holy Spirit to pour Himself through him onto everyone he came in contact with.



Dad saw life as an adventure and his passion was for every person to understand their life could also be an adventure. He wrote about it on a daily basis and through his words on paper he has shared with us the great truths of Scripture. He knew that no matter what was happening in our lives, good or bad, our true Source to finding inner peace and joy was knowing the God of the Bible. This is also the legacy he leaves. Each word he wrote was for us to have a deeper



understanding about the one person that helped him in every aspect of his life.

STATUS OF THE MINISTRY

There are a lot of emotions when I ask myself this question. When dad became ill people were asking how I was going to carry on his legacy. The only response I could think of was I'm going to carry on like he did – asking God to direct my path and for His Spirit to do His work in and through me. This brings great comfort because when I allow myself a time of reflection the fear over takes me. I knew this day would come, it started well over a year ago, I would become overwhelmed with fear of my father dying. I was getting my mind around it but just didn't expect it so soon. I praise God for starting to get me ready but I became calm when I knew it wasn't close. How wrong I was! But you see my father left a wonderful legacy...that God is in control – so I choose to let Him be!

When Dad first entered the hospital, GTN's funding was very low. Mom and I were pondering if people would want to support GTN with dad no longer a part. As we were in the middle of discussing this, a man stopped by the hospital to see Dad. Before this man left he took a check out of his pocket and handed it to us saying that God's work must continue. Recently we received a donation and a note saying "as long as you keep the doors open I will support your ministry." Since then we have had many of these "God experiences."

Mom, Dad and I had a lot of plans in place for Global Training Network and Mom and I will carry on those plans by continuing to counsel, teach and publish material. Due to receiving the memorials in honor of my father, we have been able to do the following:

- Publish Jim's latest book *Legacy, a Devotion*.

- Saturday, June 14, we gave a discipleship training to a special group of ladies with EVE Ministries.
- Jim finished rewriting *Pneumanetics Book 14 Father-Hunger/MotherHunger (AWOL Parents)* in late 2013 and we received it from the editor in March of this year so we now have all 18 books professionally edited. This has been a long and tedious process and we praise God that they are ready completed! We are updating the covers and the formatting of all 18 Pneumanetics books and they will be printed soon.
- We are in the process of putting all of Jim's published books, including all 18 Pneumanetics books, in Amazon's eBooks and Apples's iBooks.
- Finished translating Book 14 "*FatherHunger/Mother-Hunger (AWAOL Parents)*" into Spanish which means we now have all 18 Pneumanetics Original books in Spanish! We are preparing covers, formatting and then printing these books.

- The remaining 7 books that are published in English are now in the process of being translated into Spanish.

- We lost our website in December 2013 and we are in the process of getting a new website. More about this in our next newsletter.

We are so honored that God wants this ministry to continue and we thank each one of you that has confirmed it by your financial support, your memorial to my father's legacy and/or encouraging words!

CUBA MISSION TRIP

February 16 - 22, 2014 — Cancelled

Twelve hours before our team was to leave OKC for Cuba, the Cuban government denied our visas, revoked the permit to the camp and forbid the 300 Cuban pastors to attend the conference so our trip was cancelled. The ministry outreach through Reaching Souls International was becoming established and having a high impact to the point a high profile Judge had recently become a Christian. Anytime a ministry begins to make an impact the government takes notice and starts an assault on

the group. Please pray for the continuing mighty work of God in Cuba that is evident in spite of the government interference.

The pastors in Cuba reviewed GTN's material and would like to have us come and teach. Christi plans on taking a teaching team and is praying for God's direction. The funds that were designated for the Cuba trip will be used for Christi's mission trip to Peru, future international and local ministry work.

Counselees: for us to pour God's love and wisdom onto them so He is more real than anything they are dealing with. That God will allow us to provide comfort in their time of need.

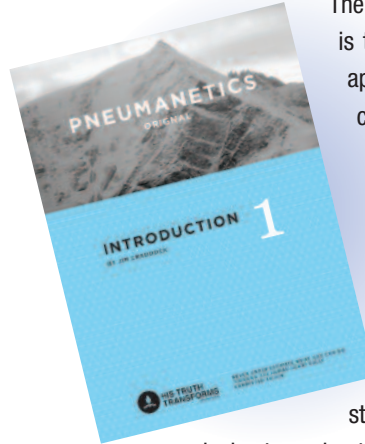

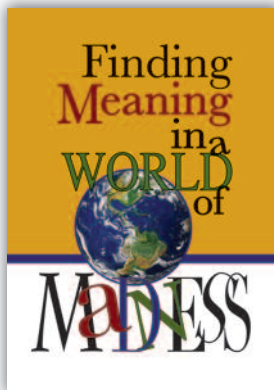


Finding Meaning in a World of Madness
